**Survey for Attending Online or Regular (In School) Classes**

Dear Parents,

Greetings!

Based on the directive by His Royal Highness Prince Salman Bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince, Deputy Supreme Commander and First Deputy Prime Minister, we have been informed by the Ministry of Education, Kingdom of Bahrain to conduct a survey to get opinion whether your ward will attend the classes online or come to the school from September onwards. In this regard we request you to give your opinion by filling up the Google Form which can be accessed through the link <https://forms.gle/f6mdGZAziCFuE42V6> on or before 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2020.

In the event of starting regular classes we would like to bring the following points to your kind attention.

1. The online classes will continue for all the classes from 02<sup>nd</sup> September, 2020 as per the schedule.
2. Based on the survey school will decide on conducting regular classes giving top priority to the safety of the students and teachers as per the Ministry of Education guidelines regarding the class room capacity and other parameters.
3. The students should adhere to the safety protocol pertaining to COVID-19 issued by the Government of Bahrain, Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education. The entry into the campus will be subject to wearing of face mask and the result of thermal scanning.
4. The regular classes shall resume in phased manner beginning with the main subjects of senior classes. The classes will be scheduled on rotational basis. The students opted for regular classes shall attend the online classes on other days. A detailed schedule will be released in the last week of August, 2020.
5. The option has to be decided by the parents considering all the risk factors and challenges. The school shall not be held responsible for your decision and any unforeseen health risks.
6. The parents have to make their own transport arrangements until the school provides transport facilities. As of now, it is not viable for the school to arrange transport facilities due to various factors like safety concern, cost and other operational risks.
